

#### Sunscreen:

We are seeing warmer days, and we will be spending more time outdoors on the playground. Please ensure that you apply sunscreen on your child before bringing them to school in the morning. If you arrive at school and have forgotten to apply sunscreen, we have a spare bottle on the playground that you can use.

If your child attends the 6-hour program, please apply sunscreen before dropping your child off in the morning. You will also need to supply a minimum SPF 15 sunscreen, labelled with your child's name, that will be kept here so the educators are able to apply it to your child if the UV is above 5 in the afternoon.

#### Staying to Play on Seedling Playground:

If you are choosing to stay and play on the seedling playground at the end of the day, we just ask that you help your child to clean up before going home. The educators leave the playground set up and ready for the children to play the next day but when you don't clean up, our educators need to clean up before starting their program. Thank you for your cooperation with this.

#### Morning Drop Off

A reminder to all our families that our programs begin at 9:00am and we can not have children in our care of the educators until this time due to our licence from the ministry. Parents/Guardians are welcome on the playground but just need to stay with their children until 9am on the playground. You will see the educators moving around the outdoor space, but they are ensuring the playground is safe and setting up amazing activities for your children to explore throughout their morning here at St. John's. We know that as parents you very busy and have places to go but we ask that you are mindful of the time and give the educators the space/time to finish their morning set up. Thank you.

#### September Fees:

#### All families will move over to pre-Authorized payments through Kindertails.

Just a reminder that all returning families are required to pay their September 2024 fees by **June 10th.** All fees are non-refundable after that date if you withdraw or change your days.

If payment is not received by June 10<sup>th</sup> through Kindertails, your child's spot will not be saved. Any changes will be effective for October 1st, 2024. Your September invoice will be available on June 1<sup>st</sup> on the Kindertails App.

Your security deposit paid at the beginning of the year will be applied towards your June 2025 invoice.

All returning families will need to review and complete their enrollment in Kindertails.
