#### **International Family Day**

As Early Childhood Educator's we follow "How Does Learning Happen, Ontario's Pedagogy for the Early Years (2014)." This is the description they give about families and the one we stive to achieve through every interaction with you and your child. "Families are composed of individuals who are competent and capable, curious and rich in experiences. Families are experts on their children.

They are the first and most powerful influence on children's learning, development, health and well-being. Families bring diverse social, cultural, and linguistic perspectives. Families should feel that they belong, are valuable contributors to their children's learning, and deserve to be engaged in a meaningful way (p.7).

Here at St. John's we value the families we serve each day. We hope that your family feels a sense of belonging when you entre our school and your child's classroom.

#### Sunscreen

We are seeing warmer days, and we will be spending more time outdoors on the playground. Please ensure that you apply sunscreen on your child before bringing them to school in the morning. If you arrive at school and have forgotten to apply sunscreen, we have a spare bottles on the playground that you can use.

If you have not done so already, please log into your Kindertales app and sign the new Sunscreen Consent form. This will give the educators consent to apply sunscreen throughout the morning and afternoon as needed. St John's will supply Ombrelle sunscreen with a minimum SPF 30.

## Playing in the Rain

We are excited to announce St. John's has invested in Muddy Buddies for all the children. Muddy Buddies are a full waterproof suit to go over children's coats and winter gear to keep them dry while playing outside in all the weather elements.

Please log into your Kindertales account to complete the Muddy Buddy Rental Program. Once this is completed we will size your child for their Muddy Buddy to use during the remaining school months. The rental cost is a \$35 deposit that will be returned in June when you return your Muddy Buddy. We don't want cost to be a barrier for any family to participate in our Muddy Buddy Program and have financial support to ensure every child can rent a Muddy Buddy. For children that are returning in September, you will return your Muddy Buddy in June and we will resize for a new one in September. If you have any questions, please let us know.

#### Visit from Eastwood Highschool Students

An Eastwood Highschool family studies class is coming to visit us! Their class is part of the Ontario Family Studies Curriculum. It is also known as the 'Working With Children' or ECE prep course. It is a class of 21 senior students (grade 11 and 12).

Students that are interested in taking Early childhood Education are strongly encouraged to take this course, as it is a prerequisite for entry into the Conestoga College early childhood program.

This class will be coming for a field trip to St.
John's on Friday May 30th as part of their final project. The project includes a tour of our program, some observations of educators engaging with children, asking questions about development and milestones. . Students will not have permission to take any photos of children while visiting.

### **Playground Update**

Thank you so much to all our families for your fundraising donations this year. We are still working on our landscape designer for playground changes, but in the interim we will be adding some enhancements to our outdoor spaces.

We will be installing shade sails for the preschool playground. This will provide more shade on different areas of the playground to keep the tarmac areas cooler.

Educator Matt has been very involved with teaching the preschool children how to play different kinds of sports. We are purchasing some Astro Turf to cover a space on the preschool playground, where the children can run and play on a grass-like surface, instead of the pavement.

The seedling playground will be receiving a fresh topping of mulch that will add to the fall surface for our risky play activities.



## St. John's Nursery School Fees

Starting September 2025, St. John's will be moving to a daily fee schedule that will be invoiced monthly based on the number of days of operational days.

St. John's is closed for all statutory holidays, 2 weeks at Christmas and 1 week at March break. Families will not be charged for those non-operational closure dates.

There is no refunds or discounts for absenteeism for sick/vacation days or any unplanned closures.

We require 1 month Security Deposit to reserve your child's space.




